(HUD's FSS Program)

The Resident Success Program helps residents of Concord Housing's Public Housing and Housing Choice Voucher participants work towards becoming self-sufficient.

Joining the Resident Success Program is completely optional. Simply determine if any of the following statements apply to you:

- **Are you ready to become financially independent?**
- **Do you want to earn a degree or obtain your High School Equivalency Certificate?**
- **Would you like to own a home?**
- **Do you want to buy a car?**
- **Are you ready to shape your own future?**

I need a bigger push, is there anything more?

In subsidized housing, when your income rises, so does the amount of rent you pay. However if you participate in the Resident Success Program, you may qualify to have the increased rent from employment income, put into an escrow savings account each month! You will then be able to access these funds to achieve your personal goals.

What does it mean to be Self-Sufficient?

1. Meeting your own needs independently, without relying on others for help.
2. Having confidence in your own resources or powers.

Achieving self-sufficiency involves securing a job that pays a sufficient wage, allowing one to become financially independent.
